FOOTNOTE 1

New 18+ Voters and Form 6 Directive

The ECI has reported that 1.87 crore new electors were added through Forms 6 and 6A applications. However, it has not specifically disclosed the categories to which these electors belong, whether they were first-time voters, previously deleted electors seeking re-enrolment, migrated voters, overseas electors, or any other category. Nor has it disclosed the district-wise and constituency-wise break-up of these additions. New 18 years plus voters, However ECI wanted those who were deleted in SIR Enumeration to apply on Form No. 6 and Supreme Court directed the Political Parties to activate their BLAs to help such electors who stood deleted.

FOOTNOTE 2

Total deletion in SIR across the 14 States/UTs and Form 6/6A/additions

Who then are these unexplained 5.29 crore final voters from 14 states, what has been the process followed for their inclusion into the final Voter's List? The Table below explains the illogical process of deletions/inclusions, state-wise: Total deletion in SIR across the 14 States/UTs and Form 6/6A/additions. The SIR exercise began with 61.38 crore electors. After deleting 5.29 crore electors and adding 1.87 crore electors, the final electoral roll should have contained approximately 57.96 crore electors. However, the final electoral rolls published by the ECI show only 55.17 crore electors including 1.87 crore newly added electors, leaving an unexplained gap of about 2.79 crore "Vanished Electors".

FOOTNOTE 4

The final press release of the ECI related to Bihar dated September 30, 2025 stated 3.66 lakh names were permanently deleted after detailed statutory verification, while 21.53 lakh eligible electors were added through Form-6 (First Time Voter) applications during claims-and-objections process. As a result, the final electoral roll stood at approximately 7.42 crore electors. The pre-SIR electoral roll contained 7.89 crore electors, whereas the finalised roll contained 7.42 crore electors. This represents a net reduction of approximately 47 lakh electors. However, the final roll has an unexplained deficit of 21.81 lakh Voters whose removal/absence has simply not been explained by the ECI!

2. This large-scale exercise was made successful through the sincere efforts of Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) Bihar, District Election Officers (DEOs) of all 38 districts, 243 Electoral Registration Officers (EROs), 2,976 Assistant Electoral Registration Officers (AEROs), around 1 lakh Booth Level Officers (BLOs), lakhs of volunteers and the full involvement of all the 12 major Political Parties , including their district presidents and over 1.6 lakh Booth Level Agents (BLAs) appointed by them.
3. The Commission also thanks the **print, electronic and online media** for regularly spreading awareness and their feedback throughout the process.
4. Regular meetings with political parties were conducted to explain SIR process & keep them informed throughout. **By 20 July 2025**, CEO/DEOs/EROs/BLOs had shared booth-level lists with political parties of electors who were reported as deceased, whose enumeration forms were not received, who had permanently migrated, or who could not be traced, with the objective of identifying eligible voters. **Draft Electoral Roll** was also shared with all political parties. Also, list of names not included in draft roll was displayed on DEO/DMs (district-wise) as well as on the CEO Bihar website for public viewing.
5. SIR exercise was carried out in line with **Article 326** of Constitution & ECI's motto of *"no eligible voter to be left out, and no ineligible person to be included in the Electoral rolls"*
6. If any eligible person still wishes to apply for inclusion of their name in Electoral Roll, they can submit an application up to ten days before last date for filing nominations for election.
7. If any person is not satisfied with decision of ERO regarding an entry in final electoral roll, they may, **under Section 24 of the RP Act, 1950**, file a **first appeal** before District Magistrate and a **second appeal** before CEO.

FOOTNOTE 5

However, Form No. 6 [only for the registration of new voter as amended], as amended by the Ministry of Law and Justice through the Notification dated 17.06.2022, requires every applicant to declare that he or she has never been enrolled as an elector before. This creates a serious difficulty for persons whose names were deleted during the SIR process. Such individuals were previously registered voters and therefore cannot truthfully make a declaration that they were never electors. The requirement effectively compels deleted electors to submit a false declaration in order to seek re-enrolment. This is particularly concerning because the ECI's own guidelines warn against furnishing false information.

FOOTNOTE 6

On February 28, 2026, the Chief Electoral Officer, West Bengal, released a press release announcing the publication of the final electoral roll and electorate data: in the declaration of elections vide release dated 15.03.2026 by ECI. In West Bengal, the baseline electorate started at 7,66,37,529 names. The Commission notified deletions in the Draft Roll of 58,20,899 Voters, which, thereafter, inexplicably ballooned to a Final Deletion figure of 83.86 Lakh names—an un-categorised surge of over 25.65 Lakh voter removals. This creates an unexplained expulsion/decrease in the Electoral Rolls of 39,80,956 electors, proving that the final published database does not reconcile.

In compliance with the Orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide Writ Petition (Civil) No. 1089/2025 Dated 20/02/2026 & 24/02/2026 and instructions of the Election Commission of India vide No. 23/2025-ERS (Vol. II) Dated 27th October 2025 & No. 23/2025-ERS(Vol.II) Dated 10th February 2026, the electoral roll has been published on 28/2/2026.

The Election Commission of India (ECI) is currently in the final stages of the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) 2026 for West Bengal's electoral rolls, following instruction No. 23/2025/ERS (Vol.II) dated 27 October 2025. This revision uses 01 January 2026 as the qualifying date for new electors.

The main objective is to ensure inclusion of all the eligible electors and exclusion of all the ineligible electors with full transparency at every stage of the process. The revision process utilized a 100% physical verification strategy, where Booth Level Officers (BLOs) personally managed the distribution and collection of enumeration forms. This exhaustive approach ensured the integrity of the electoral roll by successfully identifying and removing ineligible entries, specifically addressing deceased individuals, permanent out-of-state migrations, and duplicate registrations.

- Those who have completed 18 years as on 01.01.2026 apply for inclusion during the Special Intensive Revision and the prospective electors completing 18 years on 01.04.2026, 01.07.2026 and 01.10.2026 could apply online through <https://voters.eci.gov.in> or ECINET mobile App or through the Booth Level Officer (BLO) concerned.

- Electors are advised to verify their names in the Electoral Roll and if required, submit applications for inclusion (Form-6/6A), Correction (Form-8) or deletion (Form-7) through online or offline modes.

FOOTNOTE 7

Instead, the published data of General Electors post SIR in West Bengal depicts the same to be 6,44,52,609. This creates an unexplained expulsion/ decrease in the Electoral Rolls of 39,80,956 electors, proving that the final published database does not reconcile with the documented additions and removals. Who are these 39, 80, 956 Voters, from which Districts in Bengal and what is their gender and other identity? Do the Bengali and Indian people not deserve to know? The entire SIR process therefore has been clouded in opacity. Reasons are that there has been absence of any clarity on the category-wise distinctions.

FOOTNOTE 8

Even if we count the 27.10 lakh removed on basis of “logical discrepancies”, the figures leave an unexplained gap of 12,70,956 electors, a number still unexplained given the mathematical subtraction. When this staggering number of 27.10 lakh of Voters excluded under the vague/unexplained category of “logical discrepancy was pointed out to the Supreme Court, the SC inexplicably ruled that they could be denied their right to vote this election, 2026, and brought back in the next election if their case is found to be genuine!!

FOOTNOTE 9

The electoral database for Uttar Pradesh began with a pre-SIR electorate of 15, 44, 30,092 voters (15.44 crore). According to the Election Commission's final SIR data published on April 10, 2026, 2, 88, 74, 067 names added in footnote 10 were deleted from the Draft Roll, while 2, 04, 45, 300 names were ultimately deleted in the Final Roll. The Commission therefore recorded that there has been an addition of 84, 28, 767 electors between the Draft and Final Rolls which may have occurred due to redressal hearings, or registrations through Forms 6 and 6A. However, the ECI has failed to published the category wise addition of 84, 28, 767 electors in the Final Electoral Roll that now stands at 13, 39, 84,792 voters (13.40 crore).

In Assam, the Draft electoral rolls published on December 12, 2025 after the Special Revision (SR) contained 2, 52, 01, 624 electors. Only 1151 electors, according to the ECI were deleted in total at this stage from the existing rolls. However, a scrutiny of the Final Rolls published on February 10, 2026 contained 2, 49, 58.139 electors. This significant deletion, that is the removal of 2, 43, 485 electors after the Draft Rolls were published has not been explained or defined by the ECI. The actual published final roll is 2,49,58,139, presenting a reduce of 2,44,636 electors that are missing from the final elector roll.

ECI Publishes Final Voter List for Special Revision in Assam, Extends West Bengal SIR Deadline to Feb 28

Election Commission today published the final voter list for the Special Revision (SR) 2026 covering all 126 Assembly constituencies in Assam, with the total electorate standing at 2,49,58,139.

According to the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO), Assam, a total of 2,43,485 voters names were dropped from the draft list, which had recorded 2,52,01,624 voters. The draft voter list for Special Revision 2026 was published on December 27, 2025. Prior to this, a house-to-house verification drive was conducted across the state between November 22 and December 20, 2025. As per the gender-wise breakup in the final list, Assam has 1,24,82,213 male voters, 1,24,75,583 female voters, and 343 voters in the third gender category. People can appeal to the District Magistrate within 15 days, with a second appeal to the CEO within 30 days.

In compliance with the Supreme Court order the Election Commission of India has extended the final publication of electoral rolls in West Bengal in relation to the Special Intensive Revision SIR to 28th February. Earlier, yesterday the Supreme Court ordered to extend the scrutiny period by seven days. The hearing phase in West Bengal should be completed by 14th February. Earlier, the 14th February was fixed for final publication of the electoral rolls in West Bengal.

FOOTNOTE 11

Pre-SIR, the state of Gujarat contained 5,08,43,436 electors. Around 73.7 Lakh (73,72,711) names of the electors were deleted in the Draft Roll initially, in the final roll published on February 17, 2026 the number recorded was 4,40,30,725 electors ECI's official figures reveal that there were 5.60 Lakh additions through various modes including Form 6/6A. Gujarat final roll published on February 17, 2026. However, the published SIR Final Roll is 4,40,30,725. This again leaves an unexplained decline in deletions of a 5.60 lakh Voters. Do the people of Gujarat and India not deserve to know who the deletion voters are?

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Election Commission of India releases Final Electoral Roll for Gujarat

The Election Commission of India has officially released the final electoral roll for Gujarat following a rigorous three-and-a-half-month Special Intensive Revision (SIR) campaign. Based on the qualifying date of January 1, 2026, the state's total voter strength now stands at 4 crore 40 lakh 30 thousand and 725, resulting in the net addition of 5.60 lakh voters since the publication of the draft roll.

Chief Electoral Officer Harit Shukla said that over 50,000 Booth Level Officers conducted door-to-door surveys to ensure accuracy. Out of the initial over 5 crore listed individuals, a total of 4 crore 34 lakh 70 thousand 109 enumeration forms were received by the commission, which were fully digitised. The subsequent registration of new voters led to the net addition of 5.60 lakh voters.

The final rolls have been distributed to all recognised political parties and are now available for public verification at polling stations and on the official portal, ceo.gujarat.gov.in.

FOOTNOTE 12

The final figures for the state of Madhya Pradesh, released by the ECI on February 21, 2026, the Commission recorded 34,25,078 final deletions and 8,49,082 new voters added through various modes including acceptance of Forms 6 and 6A. Despite the abovementioned figures, the published Final Voter List contains only 5,39,81,065 voters. The Madhya Pradesh (MP) figures do not fully reconcile. Starting SIR with 5.74 crore electors and after 34,25,078 final deletions and 8,49,082 additions, the expected final electorate should be significantly higher than the published figure of 5,39,81,065.

Election Commission publishes draft voter list for Madhya Pradesh following SIR exercise

Today, the draft electoral roll has been published in all 230 Assembly constituencies of Madhya Pradesh. This is an important opportunity for voters to add their names, make corrections, or get names deleted from the voter list.

Akashvani's correspondent reports that today, the draft electoral roll was published in all 230 Assembly constituencies across Madhya Pradesh. From 10 AM onwards, the draft voter list has been made available at all polling stations, where voters can check their names. In Jabalpur district, BLO Anil Kewat shared details about the process.

As per the directions of the Election Commission, names of deceased voters, shifted voters, and duplicate entries have been removed under the Special Intensive Revision process. Voters whose names are not included in the list can submit claims and objections with the required documents. Claims and objections will be accepted till 22 January 2026, while the final voter list will be published on 21 February 2026.

The final electoral rolls for Madhya Pradesh were published today after the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) with January 1, 2026 as the qualifying date, showing a total electorate of 5,39,81,065. Compared to the draft roll, there was a net addition of 84,982 electors (1,08,54,913 additions and 23,86,177 deletions), resulting in a 1.60% net increase.

अंतिम मतदाता सूची के प्रकाशन के अवसर पर मध्यप्रदेश के सभी नागरिक इस अभियान में अभूतपूर्व सहयोग के लिए धन्यवाद एवं अभिनंदन के पात्र हैं। निर्धारित समय में विशेष गहन पुनरीक्षण की प्रक्रिया पूर्ण करने हेतु 55 जिला निर्वाचन अधिकारियों, 230 निर्वाचक पंजीकरण अधिकारियों, 533 सहायक निर्वाचक पंजीकरण अधिकारियों, 71,930 वीएलओ, अनेक वालंटियर्स की सक्रिय भागीदारी रही। राज्य के मतदाताओं का उत्साहपूर्ण सहयोग प्राप्त हुआ। मीडिया, राजनीतिक दलों एवं अन्य संगठनों का भी सहयोग मिला। इसके परिणामस्वरूप कुल 5,74,06,143 मतदाताओं में से 5,31,31,983 मतदाताओं से गणना प्रपत्र प्राप्त हुए, जिनका पूर्ण डिजिटलीकरण किया गया। वीएलओ द्वारा निरंतर घर-घर सर्वेक्षण किया गया, जिसमें दिवंगत, स्थायी रूप से स्थानांतरित तथा दो स्थानों पर पंजीकृत मतदाताओं की पहचान की गई।

SIR की घोषणा के पश्चात राज्यभर में 5.74 करोड़ मतदाताओं को गणना प्रपत्र वितरित कर उनके डिजिटलीकरण का कार्य मिशन मोड में किया गया। अभियान के दौरान ही मृत, अनुपस्थिति, स्थायी रूप से स्थानांतरित एवं दोहरी प्रविष्टियों के सत्यापन हेतु बूथ लेवल अधिकारियों एवं राजनीतिक दलों के बूथ लेवल एजेंटों के साथ बैठकों का आयोजन किया गया। संबंधित विधानसभा क्षेत्रवार अनुपस्थित, स्थानांतरित, मृत एवं दोहरी प्रविष्टियों की सूची संबंधित जिला निर्वाचन अधिकारी एवं मुख्य निर्वाचन अधिकारी की वेबसाइट पर प्रकाशित की गई। लगभग चार माह चली प्रक्रिया के पश्चात दिनांक 01-01-2026 की अर्हता तिथि के आधार पर अंतिम मतदाता सूची सभी मतदान केंद्रों एवं निर्धारित स्थलों पर प्रकाशित की गई है। यह सूची मुख्य निर्वाचन अधिकारी की वेबसाइट <https://ceoelection.mp.gov.in> पर भी उपलब्ध है, जहां मतदाता अपनी जानकारी प्राप्त कर सकते हैं।

प्रारूप मतदाता सूची के प्रकाशन से पूर्व राज्य में कुल 5,74,06,143 मतदाता पंजीकृत थे। प्रारूप सूची के प्रकाशन के पश्चात यह 5,31,31,983 संख्या रही तथा अंतिम मतदाता सूची में 5,39,81,065 मतदाताओं के नाम सम्मिलित हैं। इस प्रकार प्रारूप सूची के बाद 8,49,082 मतदाताओं की शुद्ध वृद्धि (Net Addition) दर्ज की गई है।

The number of electors reflected in the final figures published on February 21, 2026 showed total 31,36,286 deletions and 2,42,760 further deletions from the draft rolls and 12,91,365 additions through Forms 6 and 6A in those rolls. CEO Rajasthan released the SIR final data on February 21, 2026. Before the SIR exercise, the state had 5,48,84,479 registered voters as per the ECI figure. The electors published in the Draft Electoral Rolls were 5,04,71,324 voters. There are discrepancies however. The Voters s shown by the ECI before the conduct of the SIR is less by 2,28,264 electors than the figure shows by the central CEO in its press releases.

Tamil Nadu began the SIR exercise with 6,41,14,587 voters. The Draft Voter List removed 97, 37, 831 names, reducing the electorate to 5,43,76,756. During the claims and objections period, 27.53 lakh voters were added through Forms 6 and 6A, while another 4.23 lakh names were deleted. The Final Voter List published on February 23, 2026 stood at 5,67,07,380 voters, reflecting a net and unexplained deduction of 74,07,207 voters from the pre-SIR electorate.

As per the direction of the Election Commission of India, the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of Electoral Rolls, 2026, with reference to 01.01.2026 as the qualifying date, was conducted in the State of Tamil Nadu from 27.10.2025 to 23.02.2026. The Final Electoral Roll has been published today i.e. 23.02.2026.

2. As on 27.10.2025 there were 6,41,14,587 electors enrolled in the Electoral Roll. After completion of the Enumeration Phase under the Special Intensive Revision 2026, the draft roll was published on 19.12.2025 having a total number of electors as 5,43,76,756. Subsequently, during the period for filing of Claims and Objections from 19.12.2025 to 30.01.2026, 27.53 lakh eligible electors were added, and 4.23 lakh ineligible persons electors were deleted. Accordingly, the Final Electoral Roll, 2026 has been published on 23.02.2026 with list of eligible electors.

3. The final electorate as on 23.02.2026 is 5,67,07,380 (Male :2,77,38,925; Female : 2,89,60,838; Third Gender : 7,617). The number of electors in the age group of 18-19 years is 12.51 lakh, electors marked as Persons with Disability is 4.63 lakh and senior citizen electors (85+) are 3.99 lakh.

4. Further, as per the final electoral roll, the Assembly Constituency with the highest number of electors is 27-Shozhinganallur Assembly Constituency in Chengalpattu district with 5,36,991 electors (Male: 2,62,621; Female: 2,74,254; Third Gender: 116). Next highest is 6. Avadi Assembly Constituency of Thiruvallur district with 4,28,772 electors (Male: 2,09,662; Female: 2,19,035; Third Gender: 75).

5. The lowest number of electors are in 18-Harbour Assembly Constituency in Chennai district with 1,16,896 electors (Male: 58,221; Female: 58,620; Third Gender: 55). Second lowest is 16-Egmore (SC) Assembly Constituency of Chennai District with 1,34,879 electors (Male: 65,677; Female: 69,149; Third Gender: 53).

6. The final electoral roll is available in CEO's website <https://elections.tn.gov.in>. Electors can check their names by visiting the same.

7. An appeal against the decision of the Electoral Registration Officer can be preferred before the District Magistrate within 15 days under section 24(a) of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 read with Rule 27 of the Registration of the Electors Rules, 1960. If dissatisfied with the first appeal decision, a second appeal may be preferred before the Chief Electoral Officer within 30 days of the District Magistrate's order as per section 24(b) of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 read with Rule 27 of the Registration of the Electors Rules, 1960.

8. Electors are requested to verify their names in the Electoral Roll and, if required, submit applications for inclusion (Form-6), correction (Form-8), or deletion (Form-7) through online or offline modes.

9. First time electors in the age group 18-19 years and existing electors who have applied for corrections or have shifted to Tamil Nadu will be issued EPICs through Speed Post to their registered residential address.

10. The period of Continuous Updation is in operation from 23.02.2026 onwards. All eligible citizens who have completed 18 years as on 01.01.2026, but do not find their names in the Electoral Rolls can apply in the following ways:-

I. By visiting the respective offices of the Electoral Registration Officers and submitting Form - 6

II. By applying online through <https://voters.eci.gov.in/>

III. Through "Voter Helpline App" available in google play store or through BLOs during the continuous updation.

11. For any election related clarification, the public may contact the dedicated toll free help line number 1950 uniformly across the State. The State Contact Center is functioning in the office of the Chief Electoral Officer with the toll free number 1800-4252-1950.

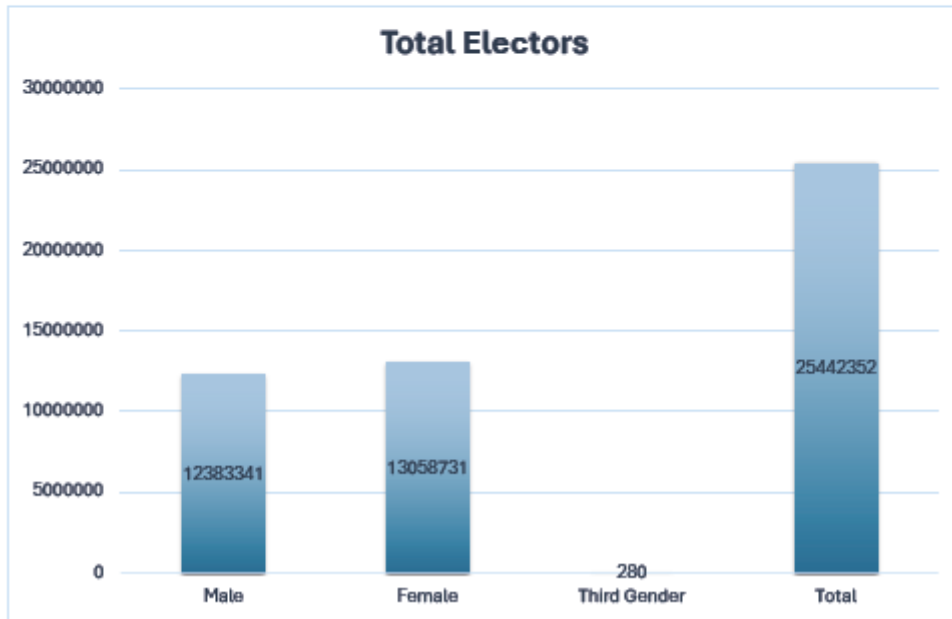
Kerala had 2,78,59,855 voters as per CEO Kerala when the SIR exercise began in November 2025. The Draft Voter List published on December 23, 2025 excluded 24,17,503 names classified as absent, dead or shifted, bringing the electorate down to 2,54,42,352 in the draft list. During the verification process, notices were issued to 19.32 lakh voters to establish their link with the 2002 electoral roll, while 17.56 lakh voters underwent hearings over logical discrepancies. After objections were considered, 15, 11, 292 voters were added and 53,229 more names were deleted.

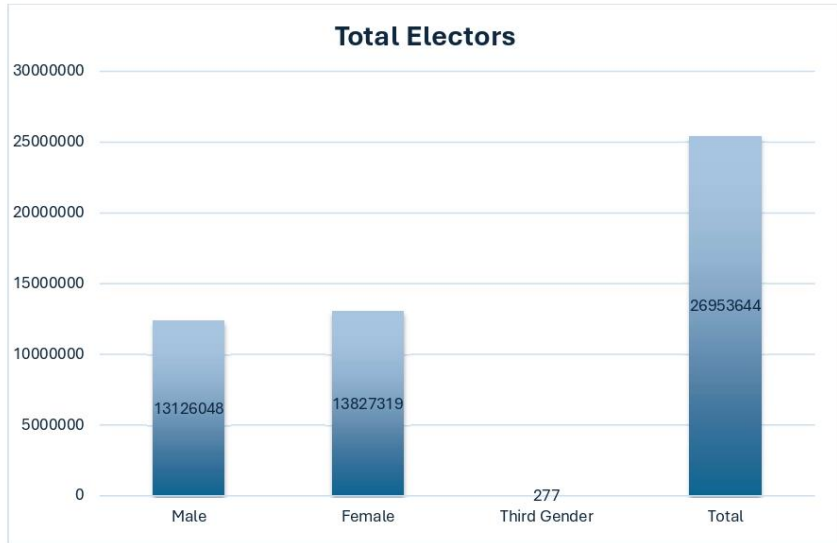

Goa had 11,85,034 registered voters before the SIR exercise. The Draft Voter List published on December 16, 2025 removed 1,00,042 names, bringing the voter count down to 10,84,992. The Election Commission also identified 1,82,403 voters as “unmapped” and 58,923 voters as having “logical discrepancies”, whose cases were later examined through notices, hearings and document checks. During the claims & objections period, 12,166 new voters were added (Form 6,6A), while

39,592 names were finally deleted, including 35,780 voters declared ineligible after scrutiny. The final voter list published on February 21, 2026 contained 10, 57, 566 voters.

Whereas, after the Special Intensive Revision 2026 with qualifying date 01/01/2026, in the final roll which is published on 21/02/2026, the total number of electors are **10,57,566**. The total form 6 admitted during Special Intensive Revision are **12166** and the total voters deleted are **39592**. There is 100% photo coverage along with 100% EPIC coverage for general electors. Total overseas electors enrolled as on date is 22.

the additions and deletions recorded after the draft stage. However, compared to the pre-SIR electorate, the final roll is lower by 52,364 voters. While the final deletion figure records only 5,269 removals, the published data does not explain how this overall reduction of 52,364 voters was arrived at, or how many of the 64,014 names deleted in the draft list were restored after verification or not.

Lakshadweep had 57,813 registered voters before the SIR exercise. The draft voter list published on December 16, 2025 removed 1,429 names, including 705 deceased voters, 210 permanently shifted voters, 472 duplicate enrolments, 41 untraceable or absent voters, and one voter who

refused to sign, reducing the electorate to 56,384 voters. During the claims and objections period, 1,270 voters were added and 47 more names were deleted. The final electoral roll published on February 14, 2026 contains 57,607 voters. While the final figures broadly reconcile, the electorate remains 206 voters lower than the pre-SIR roll.
